- We expect all Clifton pupils to choose at least one modern language. However, there may be exceptions to this, for example, in the case of an entrant who has never previously studied a modern language.
- Students with a strong interest in languages may choose a second modern language and also Latin. However, studying a new language as a beginner is generally discouraged.
- Students of Mandarin should be very proficient to join the course at this stage, i.e. fluent or native speakers. Please speak to the Deputy Head (Academic) if you have any questions about the subject options.
